



HEARING GOD

Session 4 - *“Never Alone”* - Chapter 3

God is able to penetrate and intertwine Himself within the fibers of the human self in such a way that those who are enveloped in His living companionship will never be alone. (58)

They are living in the presence from which nothing can separate them. The complete and ultimate blessing and highest good, the summum bonum [highest good] of humankind, comes to those with lives absorbed in the Way of Christ - life in the presence of God. (59)

The Giver and His Gifts — *A Priestly Kingdom*

The basic idea is that God calls us to a direct and fully self-conscious, personal relationship with Him (as priests) in which we share responsibility with Him (as kings) in the exercise of His authority. (62)

“You shall be for me a priestly kingdom and a holy nation.”
Exodus 19:6

“But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s special possession, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light.” 1 Peter 2:9

The Giver and His Gifts — *A Priestly Kingdom*

What does this involve?

How do we experience it?

1. Blind Faith - Past experiences, faith in the faith of others or abstract reasonings.
2. Sensing God's Presence - A very powerful sense, feeling or impression.
3. A God Who Acts - Extraordinary events or powerful effects. (Acts 14:27)
4. Conversational Relationship - Would not a personal God also talk with us?

Two Types of Guidance

I. Mechanical - Like driving a car

II. Personal — 2 Ways: The Word & Work of God

#1 — The Word of God - Primarily the Bible

Ananias & Paul - Acts 9:10-16

...not a matter of theoretical argumentation,
strong impressions or baffling events.

Paul redirected from Bithynia to Macedonia - Acts 16:6-9

The Gathered Church - 1 Corinthians 14:26



#2: The Work of God — Shared Activity (70-73)

“Having the mind of Christ” 1 Corinthians 2:16

Parable of the obedient Servant Luke 17:7-10 (71, 14)

Friends with God:

Shared Understanding + Shared Work =
Concrete, Commonsense Reality

“You are my friends if you do what I command.” John 15:14

His intent for us is that we would grow to the point we would do what we want because what we want is part of that shared understanding with God, our friend. (73)

As friends...for good...as the Temple of God

The union with God consists chiefly in a conversational relationship with God while we are consistently and deeply engaged as His friend and colaborer in the affairs of the Kingdom of the Heavens. (75 & 35)

His direct communication with us, by word and by shared activity, is the most important part. This is because we are to become the temple of God. (76)

“I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.”

Galatians 2:20

God's Friends...for Good...as the Temple of God.

Mistaken Views of How God Speaks to Us (76-82)

- 1.) A Message a Minute - God is telling you what to do at every turn.
- 2.) It's All in the Bible - Unless it's not in the Bible.
- *Principles not Prescriptions - God giving you a message.*
- 3.) Whatever Comes is God's Will
- *And I'm not responsible.*

The obedience of Jesus rested in His mature will and understanding of His life before God, not on always being told "Now do this" and "Now do that". (77)

God speaks ultimately to the mature Christian. (77)

We become so close to God we don't have to wait to hear His words. We don't have to be asked but are engaged in free-hearted collaboration with Jesus and His friends in the Kingdom.







Dallas takes the idea of hearing God out of the context of religion and puts it in the context of real life. Then he provides a solid theological foundation for discussing the idea of hearing God. The life that God presents to us in the Bible includes the assumption that God will be speaking to us (Ps. 32, Is. 30), but many people can't identify God speaking to them or think that they don't deserve for Him to speak to them. We invite you to learn to hear the voice of the Lord and develop a conversational relationship with Him.
