Now available. *"Repent, the Kingdom of God is at hand."* (Mt. 4:17)

Fully affordable. *"Blessed are the poor, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven."* (Mt. 5:4)

Totally adaptable. *"May Your Kingdom come, Your will be done right here in my world as it is in Heaven."* (Mt. 6:10)

Completely accessible. *"Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness."* (Mt. 6:33)

Selectively optional. *"The Kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit."* (Mt. 21:43)

Freely transferable. *"As you go, proclaim this message: 'The kingdom of heaven has come near'."* (Mt. 10:7)

How does the Kingdom of God operate?

The kingdom starts very small (mustard seed), grows quietly (yeast) and unassisted (all by itself) inviting a child like response to sell out completely to gain the prize of the Kingdom. The Kingdom will exist side by side with other kingdoms until the King separates good from evil when the Kingdom will be celebrated like a Wedding Dinner.
