





Session 14 Review

27 "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' 28 But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman to lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart. 29 If your right eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. 30 And if your right hand causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to go into hell."

31 "It has been said, 'Anyone who divorces his wife must give her a certificate of divorce.' 32 But I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, makes her the victim of adultery, and anyone who marries a divorced woman commits adultery."

If you pull contempt and unrestrained anger out of human life, you have thereby rid it of by far the greater part of wrong acts that actually get carried out.

Life Area #2 - Lust

Jesus' teaching here is that a person who cultivates lusting in this manner is not the kind of person who is at home in the goodness of God's kingdom. (160)

- -> (def.) To look upon a woman for the purpose of lusting for her. Usually the only thing lacking for overt action is the occasion. The adulterer is the one who would have wrongful sex if the circumstances were right...if he/she could not be found out.
- -> It is always acted out to some degree and can not be kept a private reality. The look restructures the entire framework of personal relations where it occurs.
- = *Gone* Sexual harassment and unfair treatment of those suffering silently who don't attract the lusting look.

A Thief is not just one who steals.

A Thief is one who would steal if the opportunity presents itself.



Life Area #2 (continued) — Adultery

Actual adultery is much worse.

Personal relationship has been emptied out to the point where intimacy is impossible.

Contemporary human beings can not find a reason for not committing adultery. (163)

Anger + Contempt = destroyed marriage sex = fantasy Pornography involves contempt or disgust. (163-164)

Thinking of or tempted by sex is not wrong versus looking with a purpose to desire - a desire to desire.

For many it is a chosen habit. They are not unwilling victims. It isn't like the law of gravity. (165)

Attraction $\sim Distraction \sim Action$



Intimacy is a spiritual hunger of the human soul...for it comes only within the framework of an individualized faithfulness within the Kingdom of God.

(163)

"You need to distinguish:

- 1) Thought of sin
- 2) Inclination to sin (that's temptation)
- 3) Readiness to sin

Adultery in the heart is #3. It is not temptation. It is not thought. Adultery in the heart is manifested by cultivating desire. When you 'look to lust' you 'look in order to lust' not just having to, but inciting to purposefully enjoy dwelling on it."

Why does one do that?

"For the most part it is a habit. It feels good. We enjoy imagining what we might like to do even if we wouldn't do them. This habit of indulging feeling becomes a major part of how we get through life. Turn to the body (Romans 1) as a source of gratification and good feeling."

Reductio Absurdum of Rightness in Terms of Acts

So if the command is to not look at another with the desire to lust, then just not allow yourself to be where the "other" is visible.

Am I therefore right sexually? Is this the way of The Kingdom Among Us? It cannot change who we are.

To eliminate the act by gouging or dismembering is the righteousness of scribes & Pharisees. You would roll into heaven a mutilated stump... but still could have a wicked heart. (167)

"Out of the heart thoughts of evil proceed." Mark 7:21

The goodness of the kingdom heart is the positive love of God and of those around us that fills it and crowds out the many forms of evil. (168)



The deeper question always concerns who you are, not what you did do or can't do. What would you do if you could?

Life Area #3 — Divorce

Kingdom hearts are not hard. (172)

- 1. Divorce was never God's intention.
- 2. A right divorce is not good.
- 3. Divorce perpetuates adultery in a degraded sexual condition of neglect or prostitution.




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
