

Galatians 2:20 @ Romans

"I have been crucified with Christ¹; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me². And the life I now live³ in the flesh⁴ I live by faith⁵ in the Son of God⁶, who loved⁷ me and gave⁸ himself for me." Galatians 2:20 (NRSV)

Note 1 - "Crucified with Christ" Romans 6:6 & 8

6 "For we **know** that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin."

8 "Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him."

Note 2 - "No Longer I, but Christ" Romans 6:11

11 "In the same way, **count** yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus."

Note 3 - "the life I now live..." Romans 6:4, 5, 16, 22

4, "We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life."

5, "For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like His."

16, "Don't you **know** that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey—whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?"

22, "But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life."

Note 4 - "in the flesh" Romans 6:13-14

13 Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness. **14** For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace."

Note 5 - "I live by faith" Romans 3:25-26; 5:1-2

25 God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of **His blood**—to be received by faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished— **26** he did it to demonstrate his righteousness at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus."

5:1-2, 1 "Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God thru our Lord Jesus Christ, **2** thru whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand."

Note 6 - "in the Son of God" Romans 6:8-10

"**8** Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with Him. **9** For we **know** that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. **10** The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God."

Note 7 - "who loved me" Romans 5:4 & 8

4 "God's love has been poured out into our hearts thru the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us."

8 "God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Note 8 - "gave Himself for me." Romans 3:25; 5:8; 6:10

3:25, "God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of **His blood**—to be received by faith."

5:8, "Christ died for us."

6:10, "The death he died, he died to sin once for all"
