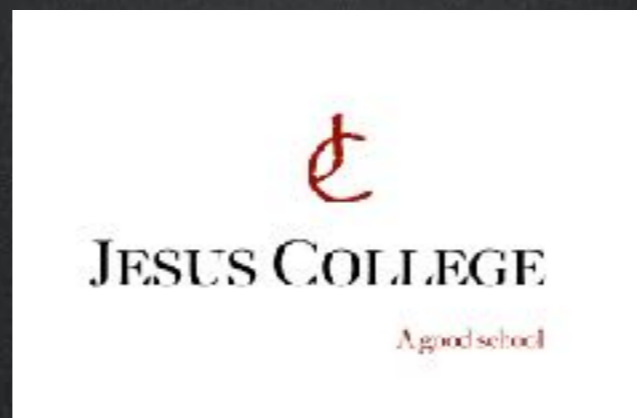

The Incarnation — The Cosmic Event

Christ coming into the world of matter

“It’s about inspiration. It’s about adoration. It’s about seeing the greatness of Jesus. And you know, I love the little baby, but the little baby is just the beginning of the incarnation.”

The Anointed MESSIAH as EMMANUEL in Matter

This causes people a lot of trouble...

How could someone be God and man at the same time?

“Well, now how exactly did the Holy Spirit? What did the Holy Spirit do to Mary? Did he create ex nihilo a little DNA there and get the combination going? And how did that exactly work?”

It's tempting to get lost in that.

It's upset Christians through the ages.

GNOSTICISM, AGNOSTICISM, MONORCHIANISM,
SOBELIANISM, ETC.IANISM, ETC.IANISM...



The incarnation theory is less important than the fact.
And we have to be careful and concentrate on the fact.

God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and has placed in us the word of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:19

God does not regard sin as the last word.

The last word is love and grace and forgiveness and a way of dealing with all of that – the atonement hidden in the depths of the Trinity.



The fact is there. God was in Christ reconciling the world unto Himself and He has given to us, placed in us, this word of reconciliation saying that's the fact.

The mystery which had been hidden from the past ages and generations, but now has been revealed to His saints, to whom God willed to make known what the wealth of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles is, the mystery that is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Ephesians 1:26-27

The mystery is not just the Messiah King coming as baby Emmanuel, but Christ in you, the hope of glory.

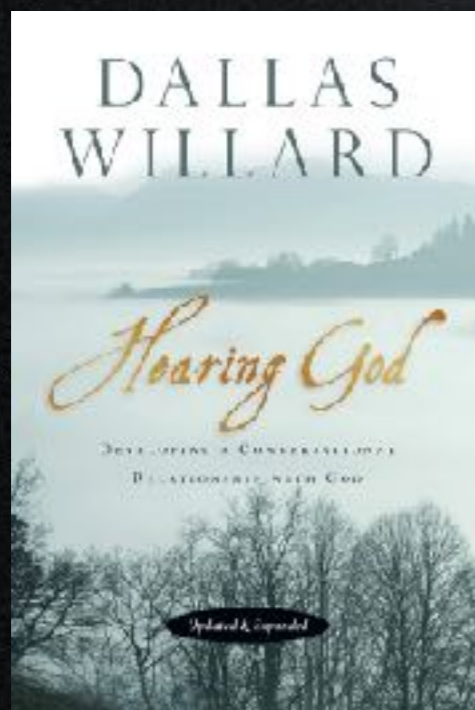
And not just the Jewish nation of Abraham, but through the Jews in Jesus to all nations. (Genesis 22:18)

Judeo-Messiah fulfilled - or - Covenanted Christ

"At a certain point in history this word - this visible language, the upholding order of the universe - came to us through the womb of Mary.

The redemptive entry of God on the human scene was no intrusion into foreign territory; it was a move into 'his own' - a focusing of that divine thought, which is the order of all creation, into the finite form of one human personality."

The Wonder of the Incarnation - Emmanuel

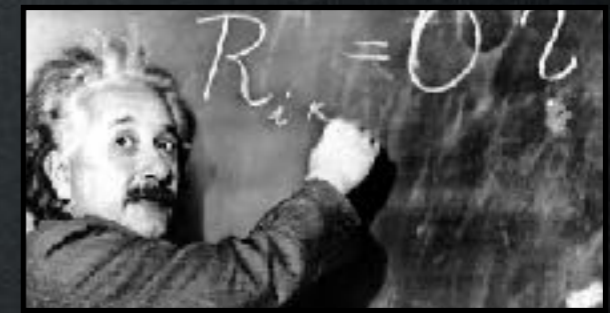
Devotional #4 - Study Guide p. 11

Problem: Low View of Matter *Incarnation = Emmanuel*

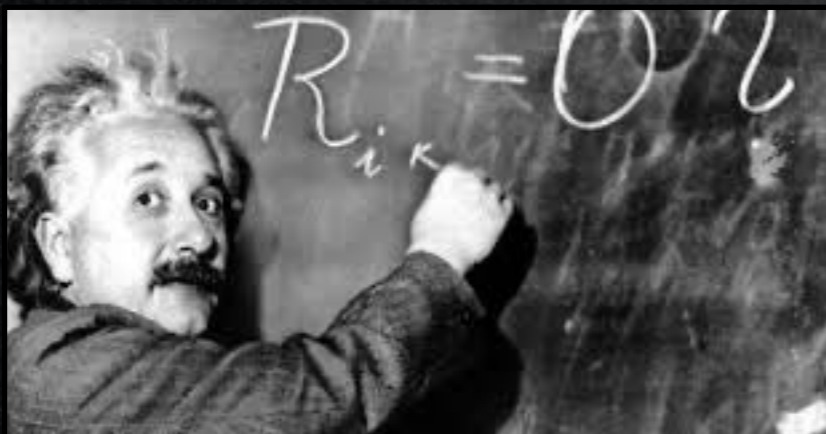

not just out there but in here.



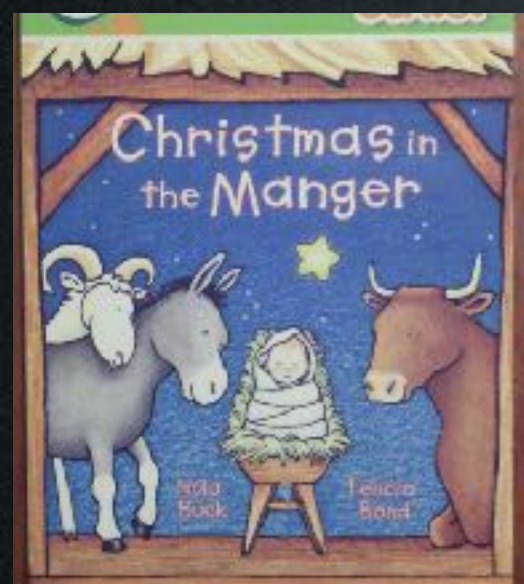

Christmas - the Doorway of Jesus into Matter

Reconciling the world - not just people, but the whole infected world that has gone wrong.

"All of creation is groaning eagerly awaiting the Sons & Daughters of God" (Romans 8:19-22) — "Brothers & Sisters of the One who came first in the flesh" [incarnate in matter] (Hebrews 10:19-20) — "to set free creation itself [matter] from its slavery to corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God" (Romans 8:21) — as "Christ in you, the hope of glory*." (Col. 1:27)*

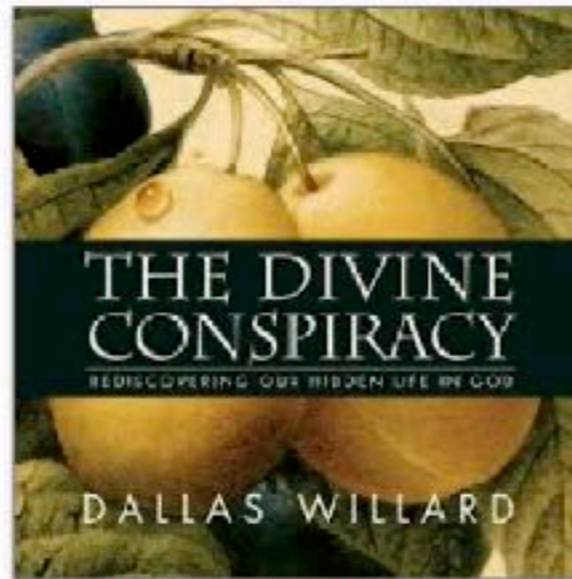

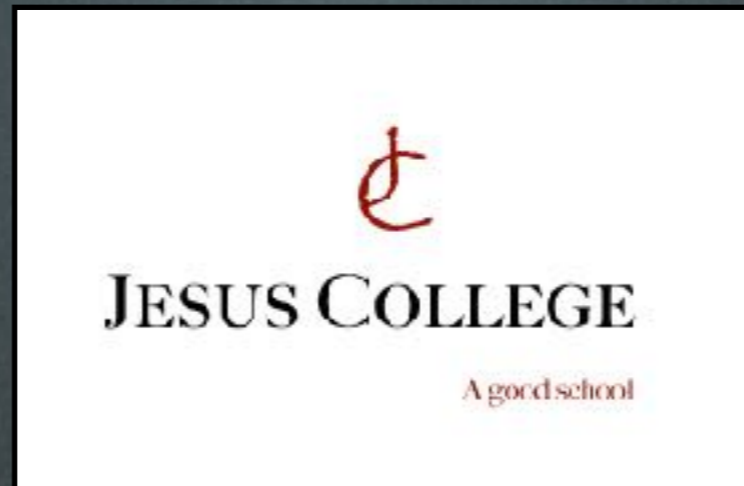

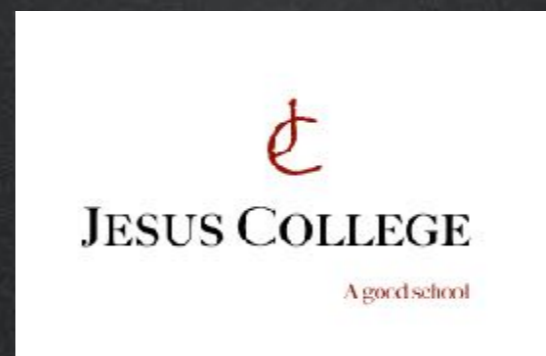
