




1. External conformity to the wording of Jesus' teaching about actions in specific contexts






“This is the message we heard from Jesus and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him there is no darkness at all.” 1 John 1:5



Primary Objectives for Christlikeness

Enthralling the Mind with God — To bring apprentices to the point where they dearly love and constantly delight in that “Heavenly Father” made real to earth in Jesus. (321)



Practicing the Habits of Goodness — To remove our automatic responses against the Kingdom of God, to free the apprentices of their old patterns of thought, feeling, and action. We live from our bodies. If we are to be transformed, our bodies must be transformed. (322) *[focus of course's next session]*



1st of Two Primary Objectives for Christlikeness


#1 — Enthralling the Mind with God

Dearly love and constantly delight in our Father.

When the mind is filled with this great and beautiful God, the 'natural' response, once all 'inward' hindrances are removed will be to do 'everything I have told you to do'. (321)

How do we help people love what is lovely? It can not exist without some vision of the beloved. (323)

If anyone is to love God and have his or her life filled with that love, God in His glorious reality must be brought before the mind and kept there in such a way that the mind takes root and stays fixed. (324)



Our Mind & Our Choices

What simply occupies our mind very largely governs what we do. The deepest revelation of our character is what we choose to dwell on in thought. (324) To “repent” - think about what we’ve been thinking. (325)

Three main ways God comes before our mind:

- A Loving Creator (326-332)
- His acts in history and Jesus (332-336)
“The key to loving God is to see Jesus.” (334)
Incarnation, Crucifixion, Resurrection, Master of Creation
John 14:23
- Our human experience of Him (337-341)






