

A - "Become an apprentice of Jesus."



#### Jesus Manner of Teaching

Jesus the Teacher - HOW, What & Why He Taught His Way

**HOW** - His use of concreteness in teaching takes yet another form...He corrects a general assumption or practice thought to govern the situation at hand. He shows the general assumption or practice to be an unreliable guide to life under God. (107)

## "The Manner of Jesus' Teaching"

Luke 14:7-15, "Friend, move up higher."

"In reference to the Beatitudes, he is saying contrary to human expectation, the poor are often blessed because the Kingdom of God belongs to them, and the rich are not blessed because they are not in the Kingdom of God. The meaning of the Beatitudes is to be understood in light of this great inversion, they are primarily the proclamation of the availability of the Kingdom."

#### How to Make a Neighbor

The story of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10) means the general assumption of Jesus' hearers about who has eternal life have to be revised in light of the condition of people's hearts.

We define who our neighbor is by our love.

Jesus rejects, "Who is my neighbor?" and substitutes, "To whom will I be a neighbor?"

Jesus teaches we can not identify who "has it", who "is in", who "is blessed" by looking at the exteriors of any sort. That is a matter of the heart.

Jesus the Teacher - How, What & WHY He Taught His Way

**WHY** - We automatically remember what makes a real difference in our life. The secret of the great teacher is to speak words, to foster experiences, that impact the active flow of the hearer's life. This is what Jesus did by the way he taught. He tied his teachings to concrete events that make up the hearers' lives.

He aimed his sayings at their hearts and habits... by showing the presence of the Kingdom in the concrete details of our shared lives.

Q — What about Jesus as "Teacher" strikes me - what he said, how he said it, why he said it?


Q — How well do I show in my love for my neighbor that the words of Jesus have fully seized me?

#### Session 11 Summary

Jesus not only taught in this manner, he also taught us, His students in the Kingdom, to teach in the same way. By showing to others the presence of the Kingdom in the concrete details of our shared existence, we impact the lives and hearts of our hearers, not just their heads. And they won't have to write it down to hold onto it.


