I. Grasping the Kingdom of God

People have a hard time grasping the Kingdom of God, a hard time thinking about it.

Acts 1:6, "Will you now restore the Kingdom to Israel?"

Daniel 2:34, "A rock cut out without hands."

It will be a very different government from expected.

Isaíah 9:7, "All the government will be upon His shoulders."

The Kingdom of God is God's effective will.

II. Safe in the Kingdom of God

If we step in to the Kingdom of God, then this world is a perfectly safe place for us to be. And there is nothing that will happen to us in this world that cannot be brought to, that will not be brought to good by God. [3A, Video 5 @ 3:10]

Romans 8:28, "All things work together for good to those who love God and are called according to His purposes."

"All" "Together" = the "chemistry" of the Kingdom

We still suffer but we never suffer without hope because our confidence is in a Kingdom that cannot be shaken. [5:19]

"I turn over my kingdom to you."



III. Our Part in the Kingdom of God

When we step in to the Kingdom of God...

We have work to do.

We are not left in a passive position.

We are not immediately transformed or rewired.

We have peace with God.

We are given the power to become students of Jesus.

All in us of the old world will gradually be renewed.

That is the process of becoming a disciple.

It will turn us upside down.




The Kingdom of God and the kingdoms of men are opposite to one another. What is up in one is down in the other and what is down in one is up in the other.

#### The Great Inversion (continued)

The reversals of life are what we now have to integrate into our own being. And that takes some doing. And it's partly up to us. The language of Paul is "put off the old person and put on the new person." He uses the word *mortification*.

Romans 8:13 & Colossian 3:5 "Mortify the deeds of your flesh."

Like a home mortgage you kill off by degrees.

#### IV. Becoming Disciples of Jesus (continued)

And this is not a matter of doing religious things.

Sometimes we can focus our efforts on religious things and have awful turmoil going on emotionally, and in other aspects of our lives, and never bring those two together.

God is interested in our failures. Bring that before the Cross and mercy of Jesus and His Father, and we invite Him to take over there. That's discipleship.

A Webster viewpoint, "The unshepherded parts of our heart."

"Jesus offers Himself as God's doorway into the life that is truly life. Confidence in Him leads us today to become **His** apprentices in eternal living. Does Jesus only enable me to 'make the cut' when I die? It is good to know that when I die all will be well, but is there any good news for life?"

"Jesus' enduring relevance is based on His historically proven ability to speak to, to heal and empower the individual human condition. He matters because of what He brought and what He still brings to ordinary human beings, living their ordinary lives, and coping daily with their surroundings. He promises wholeness for their lives. In sharing our weakness He gives us strength and imparts through His companionship a life that has the quality of eternity. He comes where we are, and He brings us the life we hunger for."

Two Main Questions - The Sermon on the Mount


Q1 — Who is really well off?<sup>1</sup> [Course session 5]

"Righteousness exceeding scribes and Pharisees..." Matthew 5:20






