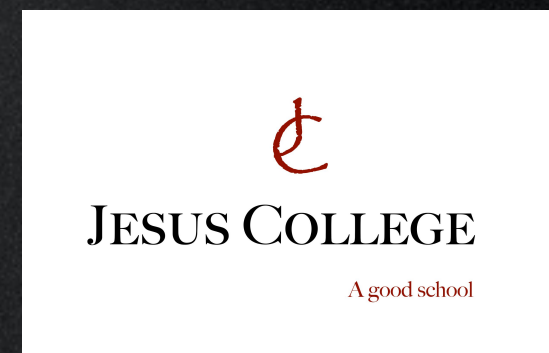

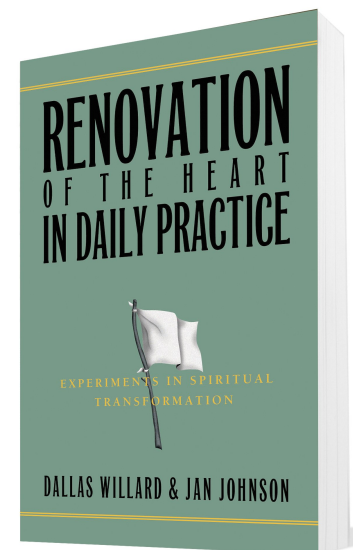

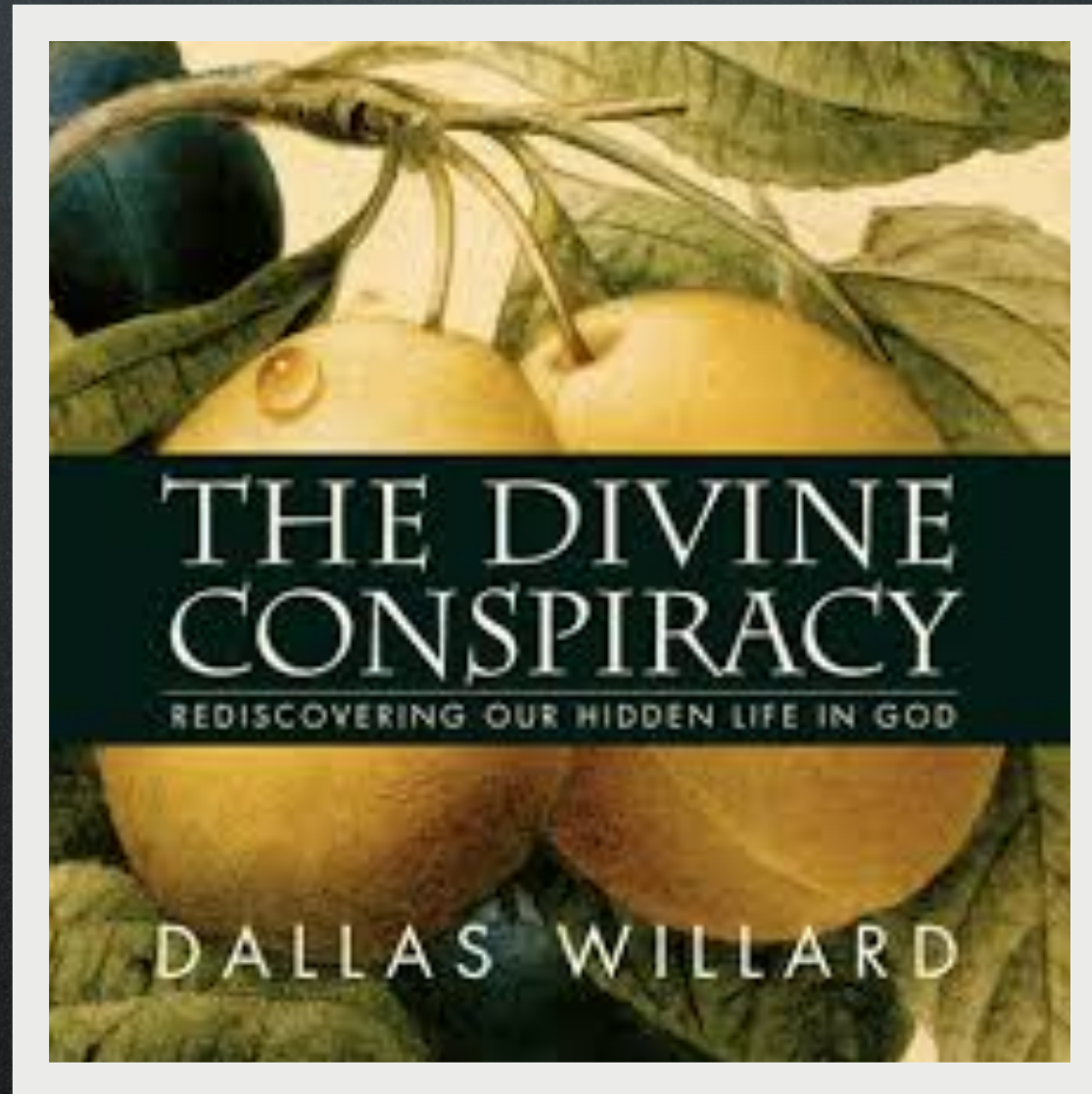

The Kingdom Among Us

We live in a Trinitarian universe, one where infinite energy of a personal nature is the ultimate reality. When we pray, we enter the real world, the substance of the Kingdom, and our bodies and souls begin to function for the first time as they were created to function. Indeed, the transfiguration of Jesus must be regarded as the highest revelation of the nature of matter recorded in human history.



“Our Father in the Heavens”



God must be addressed...failure or inability to place themselves within this configuration and receive it by grace...may be because they actually do not live within the Kingdom configuration. (254)

Take time to fix our minds on God and orient our world around Him. Our Father always near us...in the heavens. (257)

5 Requests in the Lord's Prayer

† Hallowed be Thy Name

Let your name be sanctified. (258)

† Thy Kingdom Come

Asking for the kingdom, God's rule, to come, to be in effect.

Culture is where wickedness takes on group form.
(260)

† Give Bread Daily

Today I have God and He has the provisions.
When we accept and practice Jesus' teaching on prayer, we are entirely freed from concerns about the future. (261)

5 Requests in the Lord's Prayer (continued)

† Don't Punish Us for Wrong

Jesus teaches us to ask for pity. Without it, life is hopeless...the gift of pity [in the "Kingdom Among Us"] is an atmosphere in which we can then live.
(264-265)

† Don't Put us to the Test

A vote of 'no confidence' in our own abilities. (265)
