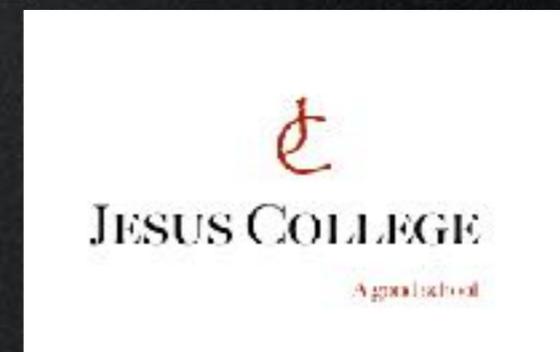

The Course Vision


To provide a vision of daily peace with the Good Shepherd Jesus lacking nothing in the full sufficiency of God.



And we wait for you to do it now.



Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.


5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;

The Poison of Self-Obsession & The Antidote to Bad Ideas About God

Imprisoned in self consciousness...a “world of hurt”. (4)

The gospel...was about the Kingdom of God – God's immediate availability, His “with-us-ness” that makes a life without lack possible. (John 10:10) (6)

“The futility of the mind.” (Ephesians 4:17-19)



Taste and See the Lord is Good

“Can’t God just move in on us and touch us or do something to us?”

We are not talking about what He can do; we are talking about what we need to do.

* Nicodemus - *“You are a ruler of Israel and yet you don’t know these things?”*

Our Minds: The Key to Our Lives (7-8)

We bring the reality of God into our lives by making contact with Him through our minds... there is nothing mysterious here. Of all reality, spirit is the most basic.

The Knowledge of God as a Human Responsibility (8-9)

Romans 1:18-21 - Ultimate, invisible, personal power.

How big of a God are we talking about?



A Really, Really Big, Joyous God

Two Fundamentally Important Things:

1.) God is an invisible being with great power and dominion over everything He created.

Genesis 11; John 1:1; Romans 1:20; 1st Timothy 1:17

2.) God is personal. He has personality. He thinks. He wills. He feels. He values.

Jeremiah 8:21, 9:24; John 14:9; Ephesians 1:4-5

A Joyous God fills the universe. It is precisely because God is like this, and because we can know He is like this, that a life of full contentment is possible.

A God of Energy

Energy is the basic reality. God is energy. Your mind is energy. You are like God. God has made you so you have energy at your disposal, in thoughts and feelings, by these you are able to exercise your will.

- * Jesus feeding 5000 (Mark 6:32-44)
- * Jesus in the Wilderness (Matthew 4:4)

Three Ways to See God's Power & Personality

#1 - God's Nature in Fire & Cloud (12-13)

“Our God is a consuming fire.”

Hebrews 12:29, Matthew 3:11, Exodus 14:19-20, 24-25

Envisioning the Invisible (13-15)

— Faith born out of experience is the means by which the mind contacts reality.

* Biblical Creation - came out of God Himself.

* Fasting - “I have food to eat of which you do not know...”

(John 4) Fasting is feasting upon God.

What God Can Do, You Can Do...Sort Of (15-16)

* Baking a cake - *Genesis 1:26-27*

* Pregnancy - “You're going to make a person!”

Three Ways to See God's Power & Personality

#2 - God's Greatness Seen in History (16-17)

God is revealed as a spiritual, invisible power that is present and moves in the lives of human beings.

Deuteronomy 4:32-36

Three Ways to See God's Power & Personality

#3 — What's in a Name? (17-19)

~ Elohim ~ Yahweh ~ Adonai ~ El Shaddai ~ "I Am that I Am"

(John 5:26)

God is an immaterial, intelligent, free personal being, of perfect goodness, wisdom, and power, who made the universe and continues to sustain it, as well as to govern and direct it in His providence. (18)

—> That is the Being upon whom a life without lack relies. Such a life is guaranteed for those whose minds are set upon this God in faith. (19)

Three Glimpses of God's Grandeur (19-21)

1 - Nehemiah 9:6 — An everlasting, eternal party

2 - The book of Job — what was going on before the earth was created, the “self-sufficiency” of God to Himself. God’s greatness goes beyond imagination.

3 - The Lord’s Prayer - Bountiful sufficiency of God
“Our Father...Hallowed be thy name.”

God’s Ample Supply (21-22)

King David - “The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.”

Paul - “Not that I speak in regard to need.”

Philippians 4:10-13

Provision of God became for them a life without lack.

They both knew Jesus - the Good Shepherd

A Vision of Glory (22-23)

Jesus at the Wedding in Cana - the infinite resources of God which knows no lack whatsoever.

God is not worried that He is going to run out.






