Merciful = Pitied - Mt. 9:27, 15:22; Romans 11:30-31

Pure = See God - Gen 32:30, Job 19:26

Peacemaker = Children of God - Mt. 4:3, 14:33

Reviled = Reward (Mt. 5:46, 6:1, 2, 5, 16) in Heaven
